## ...bring any of these items to a Household Hazardous Waste Event

### Kitchen

- abrasive powders
- ammonia-based cleaners
- chlorine bleach
- disinfectants
- drain decloggers
- floor and furniture polish
- oven cleaners
- metal cleaners/polish
- window, glass cleaners

### Garage

- transmission fluid
- battery & battery acid
- brake fluid
- body filler
- auto spray paint
- car wax
- fuel (kerosene, diesel, gas)
- windshield washer fluid
- radiator antifreeze



### Bathroom

- aftershave, perfume
- depilatories
- hair lotions, dyes
- medicines
- nail polish and remover
- toilet bowl cleaner

### Garden Shed

- fertilizers
- pesticides
- rat & mouse poison
- roach & ant poison
- propane tanks & cylinders
- pool chemicals

### Laundry

- chlorine bleach
- stain removers

**Audio-Visual:** Televisions, music players, speakers, amplifiers, video players - VHS, Beta, CD, DVD,



**Other:** phones (landline & cell), modems, pagers, digital cameras, fax machines, radios, speakers, amplifiers, receivers, video recorders

**Motor Oil**

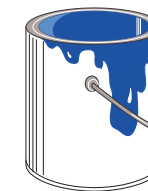
**Propane tanks** over 100 lbs in size.
