**-HHEW Depot Shutdown Due to COVID-**

End date: Until Further Notice

As a result of COVID-19 and in consideration of the health and safety of all staff and residents, Quinte Waste Solutions will be postponing operations at the Household Hazardous Waste Depot located at 75 Wallbridge Crescent, Belleville, until further notice.

We will still be operational on Thursday, December 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020; however will follow the Grey Lockdown restrictions that are being implemented on Saturday, December 26<sup>th</sup> at 12:01am. Our operations will be closed until further notice, pending further restrictions or guidelines.

This is also including our Electronic Waste recycling at our Material Recovery Facility at 270 West Street, Trenton. Both locations will not re-open until Grey Lockdown restrictions have been lifted. If you have any electronic or household hazardous waste, we ask that you hold onto these materials until these operations are re-opened to the public.
