-Household Hazardous Waste Winter Hours-

Effective Immediately

As of December 1st, our Household Hazardous & Electronic Waste Depot has resumed WINTER HOURS. These hours are:

- Thursdays 10am – 2pm
- First Saturday of the month 10am – 2pm

As a reminder, please note our health and safety restrictions:

- If you are sick, do not visit the Household Hazardous & Electronic Waste Depot. If you are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, you will be instructed to leave the property.
- Wear a mask if possible, as all of our staff will be wearing one.
- Place all of your household hazardous or electronic waste material(s) in the cargo area of your vehicle. If the material is not in the cargo area, you will be asked to exit the property to place the material in your cargo area before returning to the depot
- If you refuse, your material will not be accepted, and you will be instructed to leave the property.
- We will **NOT be doing any broken blue box exchanges or purchases at this time.** Please refer to our 'Get a Blue Box' webpage to see where you can exchange or purchase blue boxes.
- If you are a business, non-profit or agricultural business, please call us to discuss the disposal of your materials at 613-394-6266 or Toll-Free: 1 (800) 210-0762.
- Be aware that wait times may be longer than normal. If you can, plan your visit for later in the season. **Please be patient!**
