- sale price per tonne, net of freight & processing costs & adjusted for anticipated fluctuations.

 Each category of material will be weighed across the scale separately.
- All loads must be separated by material type. The default tip rate for "mixed" material or material not identified with a Bill of Lading by material type is \$160.00 per tonne.

 Do not bring recyclables to the MRF in plastic bags unless you are prepared to open them and empty the materials

- Only those material types listed on this schedule will be accepted by this facility.
 All materials must be clean & contamination free. The Board reserves the right to reject any load that does not meet these specifications.
- The Board reserves the right to downgrade any load if the load does not meet the market specifications of the grade stated when the load is tipped (e.g. OCC contaminated with Box Board would downgrade to Box Board rate.)

 • The cost to clean up any load (including time, disposal & administration) will be invoiced to the Hauler

- Subject to revision at any time.
 The Hauler is responsible for all Fees unless other arrangements are authorized by the Board.
- All prices are for delivered goods.
